Ever wondered what it's like to have sex with a man with a penile implant?

Well, writer Anka Radakovich has spilled the beans about what it's like to have a lover with a "bionic" penis.

She revealed that she had a relationship with a good-looking 39-year-old man who suffered impotence due to diabetes.

She told Men's Health: "He was so cute and funny, I didn't really care. Besides, an erect, on-demand, rock hard schlong that could go for hours? I was in."

Radakovich explained there are four levels of hardness: "limp, half-chub, hard, and 'OMG you're going to kill me with that thing.' I feared it would feel like I was fornicating with a baseball bat."

The implants — which come as inflatable or non-inflatable — are inserted into the penis of men who suffer from erectile dysfunction.
